he Board is pleased to announce that Kama aina Landscaping and Maintenance is expected to begin services on property in the new year. Budget Passed!

The Board of Directors met to review expenses and pass a budget in October. This year, we addressed an insurance increase of about 30%, which is the general trend in the industry, according to our Managing Agent at Touchstone.

To address rate hikes and cover operating expenses, including landscaping, the board passed a budget with a 6.03% increase in maintenance fees. The Board reminds homeowners that there are only certain things within our control, and to do what you can to reduce our shared utility bills.

Board of Water Supply Rate Hike Will Impact Homeowner Association Fees



he Board of Directors met and passed a budget in October, but not before a recent decision by the *Board of Water Supply* to raise rates by about 50% through 2028.

The first rate hike is set to go into effect on February 1, 2024. While the budget was approved prior to the announcement, the law requires us to have contingency funds to offset unexpected increases, which are budgeted and paid for through maintenance fees. "However, we can try to stay within budget with everyone's assistance to conserve water," said BOD Treasurer Regina Pfeiffer.

While the Board is committed to controlling costs, BOD President Chenoa Baker says, "With the anticipated utility and insurance rate hikes, things are going to be very tight in 2024. We also have necessary capital improvements planned in the upcoming year."
